Head On Portrait Prize

Organisers say "Head On", hosted by the Australian Centre for Photography, is Australia's most critically acclaimed photographic portrait competition, reflecting a cross-section of new and traditional photographic practices. In 2010, "I lead On" hat. grown to become the Head On Photo Festival, with exhibitions and events in venues around Sydney. The competition includes the work of 40 finalists, competing for prizes worth approximately \$40,000, while the festival attracts a wide range of



high-quality photography. "Head On" will be on display at the Australian Centre for Photography (257 Oxford Street, Paddington) from April 30 to June 5. Gallery hours are Tuesday to Friday from 12pm to 7pm, Saturday to Sunday from 10am to 6pm Admission is free.
