

# Mardi Gras PhotoTeam: Submit your samples

Five emerging photographers are being selected to form the official The Mardi Gras PhotoTeam—a professional mentoring project produced by McG Photographic in conjunction with New Mardi Gras and made possible with the assistance of strategic supporters.



## Submission process

### 1: Join our Flickr group

Once we have processed your application, we will send you an invitation to join the Mardi Gras Photo Team group on Flickr. (check that your spam filter doesn't hide your invitation).

You need to then activate your membership (which may involve joining Yahoo first).

### 2: Upload 10 images

Upload onto our Flickr site, 10 representative images you would like us to consider as we select the Team. When naming your files, include your full name. For example "johnsmith\_01.jpg".

## More information

### What you should submit

We are particularly interested in your approach when photographing public places, events, individual moments, small groups and crowds. We are also interested in how you handle low-light and flash.

And please include particularly innovative or studio work that may suggest your creative approach or individual style.

### Important dates

While initial applications are due Mon 25 January, you have until Wednesday 27 January to complete your submission. Team members will be announced in the first week of February, when all applicants will be notified.

## About the Program

Team members will undertake a four week program consisting of seminars, briefings, photo assignments and studio work. The Program runs from Monday 15 Feb to Fri 12 March. Two-hour sessions are held on three consecutive Monday evenings from 6pm, with a final presentation evening on Friday 12 March. The Team will be based at Moth Studios in Darlinghurst.

## Professional benefits

Your images will be used in individualised slide shows, being produced throughout the Festival. Your final folio, will enter the Mardi Gras Photo Archive, as well as be assessed by Lonely Planet Image for possible inclusion on their website (with proceeds to the photographers), and by Head On for possible inclusion in a review slide show being prepared for the Head On Photography Festival.

## Uses and agreements

Those selected to join the Team, will need to sign a photographer's agreement. This agreement confirms you as the copyright holder and seeks to achieve your accreditation where ever possible.

The agreement asks you to grant a release for use of your images to Mardi Gras (for promotional purposes), to McG Photographic (for use in slide show), and for possible sale by Lonely Planet Images. Your images cannot be used for any merchandising without your further consent.
